

**ORDINANCE NO. 326**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 44 REGARDING FIREARMS.**

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Lake Norden that Ordinance No. 44 be amended as follows:

**DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS:**

It shall be unlawful for any person except a public law enforcement officer in the performance of their duty to discharge or fire any firearm as defined by SDCL 22-1-2, including any amendment thereof, within the limits of the City unless prior approval is obtained from the city police officer. Also, a person is exempt from the prohibition set forth herein if exigent or emergency conditions exist.

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 44.**

AN ACT REGULATING THE CARRYING AND THE USE OF FIREARMS OR ANY THROWING DEVICE OR AIR RIFLE WITHIN THE POLICE DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF LAKE NORDEN, SOUTH DAKOTA.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE NORDEN, SOUTH DAKOTA.

**SECTION I.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or display any firearm, air rifle or any throwing device of any size or nature when loaded or to discharge any such device within the platted portion of the city or a safe distance there from, except by officers of the law in the discharge of their duties.

**SECTION II.**

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of Sixteen (16) Years to carry or display any firearm, air rifle or any throwing device of any nature whether loaded or not within the corporate limits of the City of Lake Norden, South Dakota.

**SECTION III.**

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Act shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10.00 or imprisonment in the jail of not less than 10 days or both such fine and imprisonment.

**SECTION IV.**

All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION V.**

Whereas this Act is necessary immediately for public safety and emergency, it is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in force and effect immediately upon its approval and publication.
